

Our school is taking part in an online contest to celebrate Maths Week London, hosted by Sumdog!

We'll be asking children to log in and practise maths during the contest week, from Friday 20th - Thursday 26th June.

What is Sumdog?

Sumdog is an online learning tool which provides personalised maths practice that children love. It adapts questions to each child, using engaging games to build their confidence, and to help children build a strong foundation in core number skills.



Making learning fun

Sumdog helps children to practice regularly, combining questions from the curriculum with fun games. The games are child-friendly, non violent and highly engaging - children don't even realise they're learning!

Keeping your child safe

Sumdog is certified by Cyber Essentials. The platform follows best practices in data security, and does not support communication between students, so your child and their data is completely safe.



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How does the contest work?

Children answer questions as accurately as they can during the contest week. The class with the highest average number of correct answers wins! There's a limit of 1,000 questions which is about one hour's worth of play and we encourage children to log in and do a little bit each day.
