The challenge faced by a big MAT

As one of the largest Multi-Academy Trusts in England, Oasis Community Learning serves over 32,000 young people. Academies are grouped into five distinct regions around England: the North East, the North West, the Midlands, the South West and London & the South East. A community-focused approach is integral to these groups, with regional teams working closely together to tailor support to their area and meet the needs of local pupils, parents and teachers. In order to bring all of these groups together and unite the whole-school community, Oasis requested a bespoke trust-wide contest from Sumdog.

Building community with Sumdog

Sumdog worked closely with Oasis to build a partnership across all 32 primary academies in the trust. In conjunction with the Oasis Horizon initiative to provide all primary children with an iPad, Sumdog was introduced across the trust to boost fluency and enjoyment in maths. Termly trust-wide contests on Sumdog are an essential part of this strategy, with personalised questions and a live leaderboard to encourage some friendly competition and strengthen a sense of community across their academies.

Oasis Community Learning takes part in termly trust-wide contests hosted by Sumdog, with continually high levels of engagement. During their most recent contest, they achieved some fantastic results:



271 classes entered the contest, racing to the top of the leaderboard



4,775 pupils worked together across the trust



Over 1.4 million maths questions answered during 1 week
